Yes, the K200A series amps need a footswitch to turn on the FX. If you search the board, we have posted a list of which pin controls which effect.

You will need a 4 pin xlr plug and whatever box and switches that you want to use. Each of the pins need to be grounded to turn on the effect.

Basically just wire each pin to a switch and then wire the other side of the switch to ground.
