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I don't know what your thinking here as the face plates between the A4 and A5 heads from 1968 and up even though they will exchange fit wise are labeled different so I can't see how you would make use of the swap?!

Whenever you remove a face plate some of the gloss black paint on its rear will come off, what I do is just touch it up with gloss black enamel from a bottle or enamel spray from a can. Do not use a lacquer base paint!
