The jack plate on the cab would have said what the cab was originaly loaded with, if that imprinting is still readable. I do not know that the SROs where ever made in 16 ohm models, so I would make note of there impedance and how they are wired. The 250 head is quite happy with a 4 ohm load. I have one of my cabs loaded with the next model up from the SROs, one lead, and one bass 15 and I love it mabe more than another cab that I have loaded with 2 altec 421A 15s.
