You will probibly have to search out a head with a blown output section that someone does not want to repair to get the clipper board. The circuit board number you are looking for is PC403. May the force be with you! Let us know how you make out.

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In that case adding it is easy, its all of 3 wires to be unsolder from the current board for the channel, and then resolder onto the clipper board, drilling the holes in your face plate (the holes are already there in the chassie) for the added controls and foot switch jack and put the knobs on and your done!
