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Welcome to the site. A world of info and the greatest guys hang here. The light bulb is a miniture screw in style. If you can carefully remove the square blue lens, I have used surgical tubing to slip over the bulb and unscrew the bad bulb. Then use the tubing to install the new bulb and snap the lens back in place. If you can't get the blue lens out, then I'd remove the amp, remove the top cover and push out the lens cover from the inside of the amp. MAKE sure the amp is unplugged. Era of the amp is around 1971 or newer. The blue light assembly hasn't been made since 1975 so take care when trying to remove it, finding a replacement would be very hard to find. Don
