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Some 15 years ago I had to redo the logo on one of my K250 covers.

I got some Testers silver enamel model paint which is a good match, and a friend gave me some automotive flex additive for the paint. I was lucky as my cover still had a good outline from where

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the logo was.

I painted in the logo with a 1/4" wide fine hair brush and it came out great, but it took some two weeks to fully dry. Had I known I could have mixed in some Enamel thinner to have it dry in a normal time.

So far its held up great and has had alot of use and recovers well from being folded.
