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I always liked them. I have a natural one. They are constructed like a Rickenbacker, where the interior is hollowed out before the front and back body panels are glued together. They have bolt-on necks and use DeArmond single coil pickups. Some models had Bigsby vibratos.

Some of the bodies were made of Ash and the grain was filled with a dark filler creating a very dark graining. They called these Zebra wood finishes.

They were only made for a few years, so they are fairly rare.

If you look at the literature section, one of the catalogs has a page devoted to them.
