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Up date, I went ahead and rewired the switch since the capacitor is no longer needed. Put a single pole 3 way jumpered so the amp will come on from either position. connected the incoming neutral directly to the PT neutral. Bottom line it works great! it even seems to be a bit quieter. If any one needs specifics let me know and I will send you detailed info.
