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Yep, they are a nearly exact match. I used them on my Kombo organ - had to re-do the way they attached underneath, so the screw heads went in the opposite way. With the nuts coming out the bottom, the thinner plate of the Lowes casters caused the ball to scrape on the bottom of the screws.

If your Kustom is Gold in color, the Lowes casters actually enhance the appearance, I think.
