Just want to say that I appreciate this Forum and all the expertise that the people give us on repairing Kustom Equipment...

I think Kustom made good equipment in its days and I still see my music buddies using them.... Just repaired a Kustom Concert L Head which someone had wired in a potentiometer to the pre-amp board circuit and messed things up especially with a hole on the front right side near the Bulb Socket....

Also the output on the back had a blue wire cut loose from the Jack.....Also, they had installed 2 / 200 uf resistors on the light bulb socket to ground...Geez!!

After watching YTUBE and seeing someone re-attach this transistor on their amp to make the bulb work, I was able to snapshot some photos and see where wires were originally soldered in their perspective places...

I re-soldered the wires back and removed the " atrocity" that someone had installed....

This amp works great now and is very Loud....The 2nd input seems to be just kinda plain in its output though...

Maybe the Bass Input...???
