If it's a bass amp it is a K100-1. Speaker would be a CTS

In the K100 series piggyback amps, Kustom offered the 115 cabinet with several speaker options in both the K100-1 two channel amp and the K100-2 single channel reverb amp. Jensen P15L, JBL D130F, CTS, and Altec speaker. Most people today think the two channel non effect K100-1 is a bass amp. It was sold as both guitar and bass head.

Back in the 60's a guitarist may not want the reverb/trem amp but wanted a single 15 cabinet with a premium speaker.

After 40+ years the jack plate may state a brand of speaker that the cabinet was shipped new with, but no guarantee that the original speaker is still in the cabinet. Removing the back may be the only way to know for sure. I've seen amps that appear to have the 4"aluminum dust cap, only to find out it was a Rola replacement speaker.

A few things I'd look for, any extra jacks added on the back panel? Original power cord intact, or a newer grounded three pin AC cord as a replacement.

I'd play through both channels and let the amp cook for 30 minutes and see if the back panel gets really hot. If it does, then you have some major problems that will rear it's ugly head real soon.

Price always plays a roll, color, any cig burns, handle inserts intact, casters roll, amp covers still with the unit? pleat

Well I would agree with Stevem if and only if, the speaker is in good shape and isn't showing signs of starting to tear along the basket. That will easily set you back \$100 to replace or more if you have it re-coned.

I've never seen a one 15 cabinet .....or is this a combo unit?

I thought Jensen's were only used in the guitar cabinets, same as the 130's. Aren't the 140's bass, or am I confused? The literature sections lists this as a guitar cabinet not bass with the 130 in it. Sounds like this is a mixed match set unless it has the CTS speaker then it was a bass cabinet....again according to the literature section.

Yes, the -2 has reverb and tremolo and is a one channel unlike the -1 that is two channel. From the picture I saw and comparing it to the literature section here, looks like a guitar head to me. You could still play bass thru it but will probably be a little on the brassy side.

Guitar Center has a K-250 bass head listed for \$99. You'd find that has a much better sound quality over the K-100's or even the K-200's since it does have the bass boost circuit in it. 2-15's cabinets are pretty plentiful as well and usually around the \$200 or so mark. I picked up a 2-15's for \$90 just a couple of weeks ago.

If it only has one Jack on the right hand face of the amp then that's for the foot switch and its a guitar head.

The head is the K100-2 reverb head. The cabinet is the 1x15" speaker cabinet, but it would be hard to tell what speaker the cabinet has in it. Kustom never offered that cabinet with JBL D140F, only the JBL D130F. Another thing to consider is that if the cabinet has the Jensen or CTS speaker, the impedance is 16 ohms, and the amp wants an 8 ohm load for maximum output. The power will be around 35 watts RMS with the 16 ohm speaker. (Stevenm correct me if I'm wrong on

the power) Not much power for playing bass.

The price on the amp and cabinet is a great price and looks to be in good shape.

The Kasino Natural Bass amp is 75 watts RMS driving the single 15 CTS 8 ohm speaker. I'd say for bass, the Kasino has advantages, better wattage, better designed bass cabinet, just not the cool factor of having T&R on stage.

Pleat, in response to your statement that the K100's didn't come with a D140, the 1x15 on the cover of the 100 catalog is a D140. The specs are above the 4 amps on page 2. I did pick up 2 1x15's over the years and the first thing I did was pull out the CTS speakers and replace them with JBL E140's. They are 8 ohm speakers to get the full output. Too light to be used for stage volume without help but will work great with a DI box into a PA or for small venue work. Conrad
